



HEMOPHILIA OF NORTH CAROLINA RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS NEEDED

- PURPOSE:** We would like to learn how having hemophilia affects daily life among persons 50 years of age and over. Since there is little knowledge about how the aging process affects persons with hemophilia, the results of this study may provide important information to enhance care.
- ELIGIBILITY:** All persons with a diagnosis of hemophilia aged 50 and over. Spouses or partners are also invited to participate.
- BENEFITS:** Research is designed to benefit society by gaining new knowledge. You may also expect to benefit from an increased awareness of psychological, social and physical factors that tend to contribute to the positive and negative aspects of having hemophilia.
- COMPENSATION:** Each participant will receive a \$50 gift card for completing two survey documents. If you are randomly selected to complete an additional telephone interview, you will receive an additional \$50 gift card upon the completion of the interview.
- PRIVACY:** **All** information will be kept confidential and no personal information will be released to any third parties. All data will be securely stored at the Hemophilia of North Carolina office.
