Alice D. Ma, MD

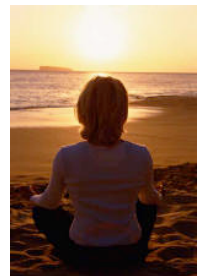
Associate Professor of Medicine – UNC at Chapel Hill
